

COST SCENARIO: Pregnancy

Covered California health plans offer four metal tiers: Bronze, Silver, Gold, and Platinum. Lower cost plans cost less per month, but mean more financial risk when you use your healthcare.

This table shows possible consumer healthcare costs for a **pregnancy**. Your cost for care and your plan's cost for your care will vary depending on the metal tier you choose. This scenario focuses on one area of health costs, and does not consider other health costs a person might incur over the course of a year.
